| roots          | <b>Roots</b> take in water and nutrients from the soil.   |
| stem           | The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.                                   |
| leaves         | Leaves catch sunlight to make energy.   |
| flowers        | Flowers attract insects and birds.  |
| petals         | <b>Petals</b> are the colourful part of the <b>flower</b> .   |
| fruit          | <b>Fruit</b> contains the plant's <b>seeds</b> . Sometimes humans try to grow <b>fruit</b> without <b>seeds</b> because it's easier to eat. |
| seed           | Seeds grow into new plants.   |
| bulb           | Bulbs grow into new plants.   |
