We are pleased to offer you our After-School Activities Programme for the first half of the Autumn Term.

Opportunities to continue learning until 5pm!

New and re-instated activities for the new school year include:

Story Club, Hockey, Lacrosse & Tag Rugby

We are delighted with the continued uptake of our Enrichment Programme. We are continuing to offer a wide range of activities with two clubs running one after the other, one starting at 3:30pm and one at 4:15pm Monday to Thursday and activities running until 4:15pm on a Friday. If a child wishes to attend one of the second activities but not one of the first they have the option of attending the after school club for a half session at the cost of £4.

At 3:15pm a drink and snack will be served to children attending after school activities, they will then get ready and will be looked after in the classrooms until the club starts at 3:30pm.

Most clubs will cost £4 per session but we are able to offer Lacrosse and Running free of charge this term.

We hope that they enjoy taking part.

Terms and Conditions

Parents should discuss the activity options with the child who should be keen to attend before being booked into the activity. Activities will run from Monday 10th September until Thursday 25th October inclusive. Charges will be added to your September statement.

Activities must be booked by Wednesday 11th July to secure your place. Bookings cannot normally be accepted after this date.

ALL bookings for Enrichment, breakfast club & OOSC MUST be made on the paper booking form provided. PLEASE KEEP A NOTE OF THE CLUBS YOU HAVE BOOKED ON THE TIMETABLE PROVIDED. This is especially important as there is the long Summer Holiday in between!

In the event of an activity not having enough interest to make it viable, we reserve the right to cancel the planned activity. In the event of the activity being over-subscribed on Friday 13th July names will be drawn out of a hat. You will be told if your application has not been successful. If you do not hear anything then your child has a place.

We expect your child to attend every session as a condition of booking. No refunds will be made for non-attendance.

If your child cannot attend for exceptional reasons then a message must be sent to office@mottramacademy.org.uk by 9:30am on the morning of the activity. If your child is ill, please mention that they will not be attending the activity in your absence message.

We reserve the right to exclude children who persistently misbehave in activities. If a child is excluded under these circumstances, no refund will be made.

Have fun exploring coding and different apps & programs such as animations, creating books, making movies and PowerPoint presentations.

Hockey – run by Ryan Owen. Cost £28 20 places For Y1, Y2 & Y3

A fun session learning hockey skills and playing games.

Lacrosse – led by Mr Jackson. Cost Free 12 places For Y4, Y5 & Y6

Pop lacrosse is a fast paced, ball and stick invasion game. It involves working as a team of five to attack the opposition and score goals whilst defending your own; requiring a combination of speed, skill and stamina. Although it is non-contact, it is recommended that those attending bring and wear a gum shield

Nature Craft – led by Mrs Thomson. Cost £24 For Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6

Learn about nature and wildlife, whilst creating some exciting and unique crafts to take home. A mixture of outdoor exploration and craft, using gathered natural materials of the season.

Projects to look forward to include making sycamore seed dragonflies, clay hedgehogs, leaf lanterns and pinecone spiders!
