<b>Rural</b>	Relating to the country (people, life or agriculture)	<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Macclesfield</u> is a market town in Cheshire (East) where over 51,500 people live (2011 census)	
<b>City</b>	A place in which people live that is larger or more important than a town	<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Wilmslow</u> is a town in Cheshire (East) where over 24,500 people live (2011 census)	
<b>Town</b>	A settled area which is larger than a village but smaller than a city	<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Alderley Edge</u> is a village in Cheshire (East) where over 4,800 people live (2011 census)	
<b>Tourist</b>	Somebody who visits a place, often on holiday, but does not live there	<input type="checkbox"/> Human features of a town might include: shops, pubs, banks, leisure centre, hairdresser, park	
<b>Transport</b>	Something which helps people get to and from another place	<input type="checkbox"/> People can do lots of jobs in their town or can travel somewhere else to work	
<b>Village</b>	A place smaller than a town
