Gaudi Clay Model Art Activity

Follow these simple instructions to recreate some of Gaudi's most famous architecture. This activity is a great way to learn about Gaudi while admiring his famous work – and having fun!

You will need:

air drying modelling clay or salt dough (see below for instructions on how to make this)

craft utensils (you can use household items such as a pencil, cutlery, the hard end of a paint brush – anything that will help you to shape and mould the clay)

an old shirt or apron

newspaper or messy-play mat

paints



Instructions:

- 1. Begin by discussing Antoni Gaudi and what he is famous for. Look at examples of his work together (see <u>Gaudi's Work PowerPoint</u> or simply research online).
- 2. Choose a piece of Gaudi's work that you would like to recreate in clay, such as 'El Drac' in Parc Güell or one of the chimneys on La Pedrera. Have a look at several pictures of the structure you have chosen and discuss the shapes included in that structure.
- 3. Then, using the clay, try to recreate Gaudi's work. Mould and shape the clay with tools and your hands until you are happy with it, and then leave to dry.
- 4. Once the statue is dry, use paint to recreate the colours and patterns of Gaudi's masterpieces.
